TWIGGY WINS AT THE ARCHIPRODUCTS DESIGN AWARDS 2022

Twiggy, the seating system designed by **Rodolfo Dordoni** and presented on occasion of the last edition of Salone del Mobile. Milano, has been awarded the **Archiproducts Design Award 2022** in the Furniture category.

Twiggy stands out for its ability to revolutionise living spaces thanks to an unprecedented ideal of timeless beauty. The armchair, which comes in small, large and deep versions (with or without armrest), is designed for domestic and hospitality settings, free from preconceived ideas and pre-configurations. A bench, a couch and a chaise longue are also added to the armchair to create a modular system that can be put together as desired with the greatest of ease. The Twiggy seating elements have rigorous geometric shapes but are exceptionally comfortable and enveloping. Covered in leather, nubuck or fabric, they are embellished with elegant stitching that brings a three-dimensionality and conveys the full depth of Minotti's craftsmanship know-how.

This award affirms Minotti's ongoing research in the creation of furnishing pieces with a strong personality, able to redefine the very concept of style and connect this with the values of timeless elegance and craftsmanship.

The Yoko armchair (by Inoda+Sveje) and the Horizonte seating system (by Marcio Kogan / studio mk27) were also long-listed as finalists by the international jury of experts including journalists, architects and designers.
